
Letter from the Pastor:

November

Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. -1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

This time of year we tend to take stock of all the blessings in our life, the things that we are thankful for. With so much going on in our world and in our church right now, it can be hard to see how we could give thanks to God. It reminds me of a story that I read recently about a man who went to a rabbi. He complains, "Life is just too hard right now. There are nine of us living in one room, what can I do?" The rabbi replies, "Take your goat into the room with you. And then come back in one week." The man is confused but goes away and does what the rabbi instructed. When the man returns to the rabbi a week later, he is even more distraught. "We cannot stand it," he says, "The goat is filthy and smells so bad!" The rabbi tells him, "Go back home, let the goat out, and come back in one week." The man returns the next week, smiling ear to ear, exclaiming, "Life is beautiful. We are enjoying every minute in our room now that there is no goat—-just the nine of us."

It can be hard sometimes to give thanks to God because our circumstances can get in the way. But Paul writes to the Thessalonians telling them that it is actually God's will for them to give thanks in "all circumstances." God wants us to give thanks no matter what circumstance we are in. One way that we can gain that perspective is to understand just how truly blessed we are. To find the silver-lining in our circumstance. Like the man in the story, we can realize that things could be way worse. But ultimately, the way that we can be thankful, even when things are tough is found in the small phrase found at the end of the passage above—"in Christ Jesus." We can give thanks because no circumstance, no diagnosis, no person, no comment can stand in the way of who we are because of Jesus.



Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. Psalm 100:4
